

Homeschool Assessment Waiver

H.B. 67, Section 6 was approved by the Ohio Legislature on March 17, 2021

Section 6.

“Notwithstanding anything in the Revised Code or the Administrative Code to the contrary, no school district shall require the parent of any student who was instructed at home in accordance with section 3321.04 of the Revised Code for the 2020-2021 school year to submit to the district superintendent the academic assessment report required under rule 3301-34-04 of the Administrative Code as a condition of the district allowing the student to continue to receive home instruction for the 2021-2022 school year.”

Note: This approved temporary language (uncodified law), in the context of Ohio’s declared COVID-19 pandemic, applies only for the re-notification process for the 2021-22 school year. If the notification of intent to home educate is a re-notification for a subsequent year then the requirement to include an academic assessment report (described in rule 3301-34-04 of the Administrative Code) for the previous year has been waived by the legislature.

This is a complete waiver of all three assessment report options listed in the rule.
